Project: Ocean Networks Canada (ONC) is an initiative of the University of Victoria and operates a series of ocean observatories. ONC deploys autonomous moorings throughout the Salish Sea which we maintain annually. They extend 10 metres above the seafloor and include a variety of sensors and instruments that measure the surrounding current, dissolved oxygen, temperature, conductivity and depth. 
